**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act relative to liquor licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 17A of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 4, the following:-

3 “on or before June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty four”

4 SECTION 2. Section 17B of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
5 amended by striking in line 4, the following:-

6 “on or before June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty four”

7 SECTION 3. Section 17C of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
8 amended by striking in lines 4 and 5, inclusive, the following:-

9 “prior to January first, nineteen hundred and eighty five”
