An Act relative to the sale of alcohol on legal holidays.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 33 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by section 202 of chapter 131 of the acts of 2010, is hereby further amended by striking  
3 out the third sentence.

4           SECTION 2. Subsection (a) of section 33 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as  
5 amended by section 202 of chapter 131 of the acts of 2010, is hereby further amended by striking  
6 out, in the fourth sentence the following words: - “no licensee under section 15 shall sell or  
7 deliver any alcoholic beverages on the last Monday in May, Thanksgiving day or Christmas day  
8 or on the day following when Christmas day occurs on a Sunday”.
