An Act establishing a virtual school working group.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby established a virtual school working group to study the
- 2 establishment virtual public schools that provide instruction to students through distance
- 3 learning, including online learning programs and courses.
- 4 SECTION 2. The working group shall consist of: the speaker of the house of
- 5 representatives, or his designee, who shall serve as co-chair; the president of the senate, or his
- 6 designee, who shall serve as co-chair; the house and senate chairs of the joint committee on
- 7 education; the secretary of education, or her designee; one appointee from the Massachusetts
- 8 Association of School Superintendents; one appointee from the Massachusetts Association of
- 9 School Committees; one appointee of the Governor which shall be an individual with a distance
- learning background; and the Commissioner of Education, or his designee.
- SECTION 3. In carrying out its charge, the working group shall examine, report on, and
- make recommendations regarding, the following matters:-

- a)Enrollment procedures including school district notification of intent
- b)Time frame of planning and establishment of virtual school
