*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The second paragraph of section 15 of chapter 76 of the general laws, as appearing in the  
2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

3           Notwithstanding the provisions of this section a child shall, upon written request of a  
4 parent to the school, be admitted to school.
