Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of section 6C of chapter 21H of the General Laws, as

appearing in the 2006 official edition, is hereby amended by striking the subsection in its

3 entirety, and inserting in place thereof the following subsection:--

4 "(d) No person shall crush, cause to be crushed or otherwise arrange for an end-of-life

5 motor vehicle to be crushed without first having removed any mercury-added vehicle switches.

6 A scrap recycling facility may agree to accept an end-of-life motor vehicle that has not been

flattened, crushed or baled containing mercury-added vehicle switches. If accepted, the scrap

recycling facility is responsible for proper removal, recycling, transporting, storage and general

containment of all mercury-added switches in accordance with chapter 21C and the department's

10 regulations concerning hazardous waste."

- SECTION 2. Said section 6C of chapter 21H, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking, in its entirety, subsection (s) of said section.
- SECTION 3. Subsection (i) of section 6J of chapter 21H of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking, in line 79, the words "mercury-added lamp", and inserting in place thereof the following words:--
- "product where the only mercury contained in the product comes from a mercury-addedlamp."
