## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven  
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An Act relative to access to health insurance for human service providers and their employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1            Subsection (b) of Section 2 of chapter 32A as most recently amended by chapter 130 of  
2            the acts of 2008 is hereby amended by adding after the words "of Suffolk county," the  
3            following:-
- 4            person who are employed by private human service providers that deliver human and  
5            social services under contracts with departments within the executive office of health and human  
6            services and the executive office of elder affairs,
