1 Section 1. Clause 2 of subsection (a) of section 28A of chapter 140D of the General

2 Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following

3 sentence:-

4 No college, university or other educational institution may impose a surcharge on a

5 cardholder who elects to use a credit card in lieu of payment by cash, check or similar means.
