An Act to reduce underage drinking.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 34 the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 34A <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>

4 A licensee licensed under this chapter except Section 29 shall be required to place a  
5 warning label on single and multi-pack containers of beer and single and multi-pack containers  
6 of wine to include the following:

7 **WARNING:** A person who provides alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of  
8 age, if convicted under section 34 could be imprisoned for up to 1 year and fined up to \$2,000  
9 or both such imprisonment and fine.
