An Act relative to insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of said chapter 93A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the word “provided” in the first sentence, the following words, “regardless of
3 whether such persons are engaged in trade or commerce with each other.”
