An Act creating the crime of criminal solicitation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 274 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2   Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following section:— Section 8.  
3   Whoever, with the intent that another person engage in conduct constituting a felony, commands,  
4   incites, induces or exhorts a felony to be committed, whether such felony is attempted or  
5   completed, shall be guilty of criminal solicitation and shall be punished as follows: First, by  
6   imprisonment in state prison for not more than ten years, if he solicits the commission of murder  
7   in the first degree or murder in the second degree. Second, by imprisonment in the state prison  
8   for not more than five years or in a jail or house of correction for not more than two and one-half  
9   years, if he solicits the commission of a crime punishable with imprisonment in the state prison  
10   for five years or more.

11           Third, by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than one year or by a  
12   fine of not more than five thousand dollars, if he solicits the commission of a crime, punishable  
13   by imprisonment in the state prison for less than five years or by imprisonment in a jail or house  
14   of correction or by a fine.
