An Act relative to malicious destruction of property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 127 of Chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 12 the words “two hundred and fifty
- 3 dollars” and replacing it with “one thousand five hundred dollars”.
