Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19C of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 16 and 17, the words “five hundred
3 nor less than two hundred dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following:- "\$10,000 nor
4 less than \$4,000".
