The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to assault and battery upon public employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out the section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 "Section 13D. Whoever commits an assault and battery upon any public employee when
- 4 such person is engaged in the performance of his duties at the time of such assault and battery,
- 5 shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for not more than two and one-half
- 6 years or by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than five years or by a fine of not less
- 7 than one thousand nor more than ten thousand dollars."
