The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act providing for opportunities for single-sex schools and classes..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the sentence ending “or sexual orientation”
3 in line 11 the following new sentence:-

4 “‘This section shall not preclude the establishment of single-sex schools and programs to
5 the extent that such programs are consistent with the constitution of the commonwealth and
6 federal law.”

7 SECTION 2. Section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
8 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the sentence ending “language, and
9 academic achievement” in line 55 the following new sentence:-

10 “This section shall not preclude the establishment of single-sex schools and programs to
11 the extent that such programs are consistent with the constitution of the commonwealth and
12 federal law.”

13 SECTION 3. Said section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, is hereby further
14 amended by inserting after the sentence ending “science or the arts” in line 148 the following
15 new sentence:-

16 “This section shall not preclude the establishment of single-sex schools and programs to
17 the extent that such programs are consistent with the constitution of the commonwealth and
18 federal law.”
