Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1.

2 Chapter 149 Section 148B is hereby amended by adding at the end of the paragraph the

3 following:-

4 (f) For the purposes of this chapter and chapter 151 an individual performing any service

5 shall be defined as an employee unless said employee satisfies the requirements of this section or

6 satisfies the requirements of any other definition of an employee which is recognized by any

7 agency or department of the Commonwealth.
