**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act relative to child labor law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended in section 78A, by striking out the second and third sentences and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following sentence:-

4 “The citation may require a person: (1) to comply immediately with sections 56 to 104,  
5 inclusive: (2) for each willful violation of any of those sections, to pay a civil penalty of not  
6 more than \$250 for the first offense, \$500 for the second offense, and \$2,500 for the third and  
7 each subsequent offense; and (3) for each violation that is not willful of any of those sections, to  
8 pay a civil penalty of not more than \$100 for the first offense, \$200 for the second offense, and  
9 \$500 for the third and each subsequent offense.”
