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By Mr. Torrissi of North Andover, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1407) of David M. Torrissi, Bradley H. Jones, Jr. and Paul Adams relative to unemployment insurance experience rates for certain employers under the Unemployment Compensation Fund. Labor and Workforce Development.

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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to unemployment insurance rates.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to lower the cost of unemployment insurance, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, the  
2           experience rate of an employer qualifying therefor under subsection (b) of said section 14 of said  
3           chapter 151A shall be the rate which appears in the column designated “E” in paragraph (1) of  
4           subsection (i) of said section 14 of said chapter 151A for calendar year 2011.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 2011.
