Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 1 of chapter 111N of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 65, the words "or the physician's
- 3 employees or agents."
- 4 SECTION 2: Section 2 of chapter 111N of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "setting" the following: "unless
- 6 the provision of or payment for meals is the exercise of ordinary hospitality for an event that is
- 7 primarily educational in nature."
- 8 SECTION 3: Section 2 of chapter 111N of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 9 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 67-68, the words "if that expense is
- part of the vendor's purchase contract for the device."
- SECTION 4: Section 6 of chapter 111N of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
