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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven  
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An Act to ensure fire safety in state buildings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any addition or major
- 2 alterations which total in the aggregate more than 7500 square feet in floor area in any building
- 3 or structure owned by the Commonwealth and subject to the provisions of section 26G of
- 4 Chapter 148 of the MGL shall comply with the provisions of said section 26G not later than
- 5 January 1, 2013.
