An Act further regulating exits in sports complexes..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 97 A of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (a) the following paragraph:-

3 The board of building regulations and standards shall require the owner of any building
4 or structure or portion thereof, that includes a place of business designed or used for occupancy
5 as a nightclub, sports complex, dance hall, discotheque, bar, or for similar entrainment purposes,
6 to install a luminescence egress route to all emergency exits and be placed at floor level. Said
7 egress routes shall be powered by electricity and have a back up battery in case of a power
8 failure. Said egress route systems shall meet state building code and fire code standards for heat
9 resistance to be a viable safety path in extreme fire and smoke events.
