An act relative to the retirement of Matthew Roy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Matthew Roy, shall be  
2 eligible to be reinstated as a member in service of the state retirement system as of the effective  
3 date of this act. Said Matthew Roy shall receive credit in the state retirement system for the  
4 period of time he was a member of the optional retirement program established by section 40 of  
5 chapter 15A of the General Laws. Said period of creditable service shall be dependent upon his  
6 contribution to the annuity savings fund of said state a member of said state retirement system  
7 during the period he was a member of the optional retirement program pursuant to subdivision  
8 (3) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws. No retirement allowance under said chapter  
9 32 shall become effective for said Matthew Roy until he has paid into the annuity savings funds  
10 of the state retirement system, a make-up payment calculated with interest for the amount equal  
11 to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from his regular compensation.
