An Act authorizing creditable service for Mary M. Dyer..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Mary M. Dyer of Watertown
- 2           shall be eligible to buy back 6 months of employment time with The Massachusetts Teachers’
- 3           Retirement System upon making payments of all amounts that would have been deducted had
- 4           she been receiving employment credit.
