An Act relative to dual pay for public employees in the military.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 59 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 10, the words “without loss of” and  
3   inserting in place thereof the following words:- "in addition to"

4           SECTION 2. Said section 59 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 13, the  
5   word “officials.” and inserting in place thereof the following words:-

6           "; provided that the ordinary remuneration authorized by this section shall be reduced by  
7   any amounts received from the United States government as base pay for military service  
8   performed during the same pay period."

9           SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, if any person in  
10   the service of the commonwealth, or of a county, city or town, serves as a member of the  
11   Massachusetts National Guard and takes a leave of absence from service as an employee or  
12   official of the commonwealth or of a county, city or town while continuing to receive ordinary  
13   remuneration as an employee or official of the commonwealth or of a county, city or town, shall

- 14 have the remuneration reduced by any amounts received from the United States government as
- 15 base pay for military service performed during the same pay period.
