An Act relative to retirement systems and pensions..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 32 is hereby amended by inserting the following new  
2 paragraph after line 142:—

3           In the event of a divorce between member and their spouse/beneficiary occurring after  
4 the member's date of retirement said member is permitted to change their designated policy  
5 beneficiary under existing provisions of this option provided that the policy is not subject to any  
6 settlement agreements pertaining to said divorce; and further provided, that the allowance shall  
7 be adjusted to reflect any changes to the policy in consideration of said new beneficiary.
