*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006

2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the word "prisoners;" in line 252 the

3 following words:— employees of the department of social services holding the position of social

- 4 worker A/B, C, or D, special investigator A/B, case reviewer, human service assistant, and
- 5 human service coordinator or equivalent or successive titles at the Department of Children and
- 6 Families who have been employed in such capacities for 10 years or more.
