The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the retirement of Patricia A. Fredericksen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 4a of section 3 of chapter
2 32 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts
3 Teachers' Retirement system is hereby authorized and directed to allow Patricia A. Fredericksen
4 to pay into the annuity savings fund of said system, for the period from September 3, 1958 to
5 September 2, 1961, the period of time in which she was employed at the Quincy Hospital School
6 of Nursing the amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from
7 her compensation had such period been deemed creditable service.

8 Such payment shall be made in one sum or in installments upon such terms and
9 conditions as the Massachusetts Teachers Retirement Board shall set forth, however, no credit
10 shall be allowed and no payment shall be accepted for any service for which Patricia A.

11 Fredericksen is entitled to receive a retirement allowance or other similar payment from the
12 Quincy Retirement Board, the federal government or any other source.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
