The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act updating the research and development tax credit.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 38M(a) of chapter 63 of the General Laws ,as appearing in
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line seven the following:-

3 “base amount”,

4 SECTION 2. Section 38M(a) of chapter 63 of the General Laws of Massachusetts, as so
5 appearing, is further amended by adding after the second sentence in line 12 the following new
6 sentence:-

7 The term “base amount” will be defined in the same manner it is defined under section
8 forty-one of said Code as amended and in effect on August twelfth, nineteen hundred and ninety-
9 one, however, the fixed base percentage applied shall not exceed 5 percent.
