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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to certain real estate tax exemptions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word “thirteen”, in line 1158, and  
3 inserting in place thereof the word:— twenty.

4           SECTION 2. Said section 5 of said chapter 59, as so appearing, is hereby further  
5 amended by striking out the word “fifteen”, in line 1160, and inserting in place thereof the  
6 word:— thirty.
