*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as

2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 171 by inserting after the

3 phrase "sales of insulin;" the following:— sales of over-the-counter medicines including brand

4 name and generic drugs and medicines and nutritional supplements on prescriptions of registered

5 physicians
