**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act relative to sex offender information online.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 178D of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
2 by section 39 of chapter 256 of the acts of 2010, is hereby further amended in the first sentence  
3 of the second paragraph after the words “subsections (i) to”, by striking the figure “(viii)” and  
4 inserting in place thereof (ix).

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 178D of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further  
6 amended by striking subsections (iv) through (viii), inclusive, and inserting in place thereof the  
7 following subsections:

8 (iv) any institution of higher learning in which the offender is enrolled as a part-time or  
9 full-time student;

10 (v) the offense for which the offender was convicted or adjudicated and the date of the  
11 conviction or adjudication;

12 (vi) the sex offender's age, sex, race, height, weight, eye and hair color;

- 13 (vii) a photograph of the sex offender;
- 14 (viii) whether the sex offender has been designated a sexually violent predator; and
- 15 (ix) whether the offender is in compliance with the registration obligations of sections
- 16 178C to 178P, inclusive.
