3 Section 1. The State owned bridge on Interstate 495 where it passes over Rt 117 in the
4 town of Bolton shall be named the Harold E. Brown Jr. Memorial Bridge in honor of the late
5 Harold E. Brown, Jr. who was killed while serving his country in Afghanistan. The department
6 of highways shall erect suitable markers bearing said designation in compliance with the
7 standards of the department.
