An Act further regulating the commission on falls prevention..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 222 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended in the first paragraph
2 by striking out the figure “8” and inserting in place thereof the figure “10” and by inserting after
3 the words “Home Care”, the following: “, 1 of whom shall be a member of the American
4 Physical Therapy Association of Massachusetts, 1 of whom shall be a member of the
5 Massachusetts Association of Occupational Therapists”
