An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Newbury as the John B. Hayden bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any rule or regulation of the department of highways to the  
2 contrary, the Bridge N-10-010 spanning the Parker River in the Town of Newbury shall be  
3 designated and known as the John B. Hayden Bridge in Honor of the Commonwealth’s Highway  
4 Engineer and Dedicated Public Servant. The department of highways shall erect suitable  
5 markers bearing this designation in compliance with the standards of the department and any  
6 existing historic preservation guidelines or statutes.
