An Act relative to assisted living residencies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, rule or
- 2 regulation to the contrary, a resident shall have a physician’s assessment completed on an annual
- 3 basis and upon the identification of a significant change in the condition of the resident.
