An Act relative to voting by sex offenders..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “conviction”, in line 3, the
3 following words:- or a registered voter subject or a registered voter subject to the registration
4 requirements of M.G.L. Chapter 6, Section 178 C-Q, whose assigned polling place is located in a
5 school, library, or community center, shall be required to vote at a location determined by the
6 elections division of a city or town.”

7 SECTION 2. This act shall apply only to Level 3 registered sex offenders.
