An Act relative to reporting requirements for raffles and bazaars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 7A of chapter 271 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 85, the words “twenty-five dollars in  
3 value” and inserting in place thereof the following words: a value to be determined by the  
4 attorney general.

5           SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of said section 7A of said chapter 271, as so  
6 appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the following sentence: The  
7 reporting of winners’ names shall not be required in the case of minor children.
