An Act to implement full-day kindergarten.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1B of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by striking the words contained in paragraph 20, and inserting in place  
3   thereof the following:

4           The board shall establish the permissible and mandatory ages for school attendance  
5   provided that each child be required to attend a full-day educational program at kindergarten age.

6           SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
7   Official Edition is hereby amended, by inserting in line 2, after the word, “education”, the  
8   following:

9           “any child enrolled in full-day kindergarten”.
