By Ms. Creedon of Brockton, a petition (accompanied by resolve, House, No. 1913) of Geraldine M. Creedon for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to reimbursement of certain school busing costs. Education.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to reimbursement of certain school busing costs.

1           **Resolved**, that a special commission to consist of the senate and house chairmen of the  
2 committee on education who shall serve as co-chairs of the commission, the senate and house  
3 chairmen of the committee on ways and means or their designees, the commission of education  
4 or his designee, the state auditor of his designee and a representative of the Massachusetts  
5 Municipal Association to be appointed by the governor is hereby established for the purpose of  
6 making an investigation and study relative to the reimbursement of costs to cities by the state for  
7 mandatory busing. The investigation and study shall include but not be limited to examining the  
8 costs of busing due to mandates governing desegregation, transportation for homeless students  
9 and bilingual students.

10           Said commission shall report to the house of representatives the results of its  
11 investigation and study, and its recommendations if any, together with drafts of legislation  
12 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with clerk of the house of  
13 representatives on or before September 01, 2011.
