## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the powers and duties of a regional school district.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 16 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding at the end thereof the following subsection:
- 3 "(s) A regional school district may serve as the fiscal agent when the region and one or
- 4 more towns or supervisory union have hired the same superintendent and central office. The
- 5 region may send an assessment to the towns for its share of the operating costs of shared
- 6 personnel and central office operations."
