An Act relative to age requirements in local elections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended in section 1 by adding at the end thereof the following:

3           Every citizen seventeen years of age or older who is a resident in the city or town where  
4 he or she claims the right to vote at the time he or she registers, and who has complied with the  
5 requirements of this chapter, may have his or her name entered on the list of voters in such city  
6 or town, and may vote therein in any election for officers in such city or town.
