An Act relative to overseas absentee voting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 91B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as 2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 4 the words, 3 "subsections (b) and (c)," and inserting in place thereof the following words:- subsections (b), 4 (c), and (d),. 5 SECTION 2. Section 91B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 6 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (c) the following subsection:-7 (d) To a voter qualified under the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee 8 Voting Act (42 USC section 1973ff-2), the ballot may be delivered electronically by fax, e-mail, 9 or secure website. The secretary of state may promulgate rules and regulations necessary for the 10 implementation of this section.
