An Act relative to unaffiliated voters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapters 50 through 57 inclusive of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2008 Official Edition, are hereby amended by substituting the words “unaffiliated voter” for the
3 phrase “unenrolled voter” wherever the phrase “unenrolled voter” appears.

4 SECTION 2. The phrase “unenrolled voter” shall be changed to “unaffiliated voter”
5 wherever it appears in the regulations promulgated pursuant to Chapters 50 through 57 of the
6 General Laws.
