An Act relative to Chapter 32, Section 91A waivers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 91A of Chapter 32, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended,
- 2 in line 9, by inserting after the word “commission”, the following words:-
- 3           , provided, however, that the commission may waive such filing by a member, if said
- 4 member shall have been retired for more than twenty years, and has not reported any earnings for
- 5 the prior ten years and also signs an affidavit under the pains and penalties of perjury indicating
- 6 that should he/she realize any earned income in the future that they will forthwith notify the
- 7 commission of that fact and again report under this Section.
