An Act to maintain the operation of public swimming pools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 2 the department of conservation and recreation shall maintain continuous operation of all its
- 3 public swimming pools and open all its swimming pools on the same date in the last week of
- 4 June and close all its swimming pools on the same date in the last week of August.
