An Act relative to the equitable assessment of bank fees..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 167D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the following: “-“,  
3   established for personal, family or household purposes,”.

4           SECTION 2. Section 41A of chapter 171 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
5   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the following: -“,  
6   established for personal, family or household purposes,”.
