## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven  
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An Act repealing mandated benefits that are no longer effective.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 38C of Chapter 3 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by adding after subsection (d) the following: -

3           (e) The Division of Health Care Finance and Policy shall report appropriate legislation to  
4   repeal State Mandated Health Benefits identified in its Comprehensive Review of Mandated  
5   Benefits in Massachusetts, that no longer conform to existing standards of care in terms of  
6   clinical appropriateness or evidence-based medicine.
