*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 24A of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the sentence ending with “certified public  
3 accountant" the following:-

4           There shall be no fee associated with providing electronic bid information to pre-  
5 qualified bidders.
