An Act providing for nonsmoking units in elderly housing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 40 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:—

3 (i) A housing authority shall provide for nonsmoking buildings, or in a single building  
4 facility, nonsmoking floors in housing for elderly persons.

5 SECTION 2. The provisions of section 1 shall be accomplished on a phased-in basis and  
6 shall not result in the eviction of any tenant.
