## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to juvenile intimidation of witnesses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 119 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended in the

2 third paragraph of section 54 by adding after the words "chapter two hundred and sixty-nine," in

- 3 first sentence the following:- or the person has committed a violation of section thirteen B of
- 4 chapter two hundred and sixty-eight,
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
