## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the advisory committee on personnel standards.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 211B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the first paragraph and inserting in its place the

3 following: --

4 "There shall be an advisory committee on personnel standards. The membership of the 5 committee shall consist of the following persons: the chief justice for administration and 6 management or his designee who shall serve as chair of the committee, the chief justices of the 7 trial court departments, three (3) clerk of courts appointed by the superior court clerks 8 association, three (3) district court clerks appointed by the district court clerks association, three 9 (3) reregisters of probate, three (3) Juvenile Clerk Magistrates and the commissioner of probation."
